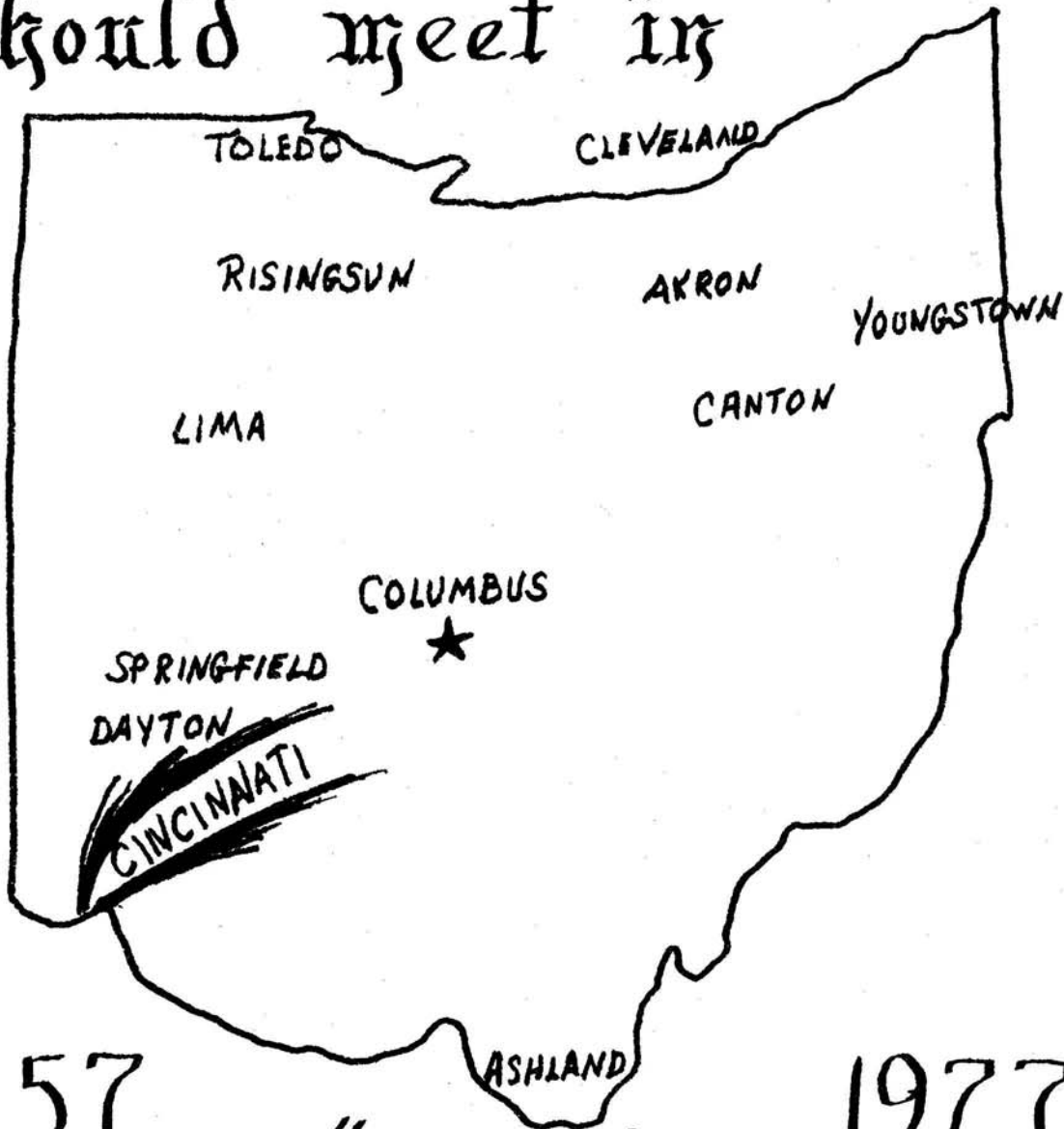
Have been neglectful in the past to send my dues for membership in the 96th Infantry Division Association.

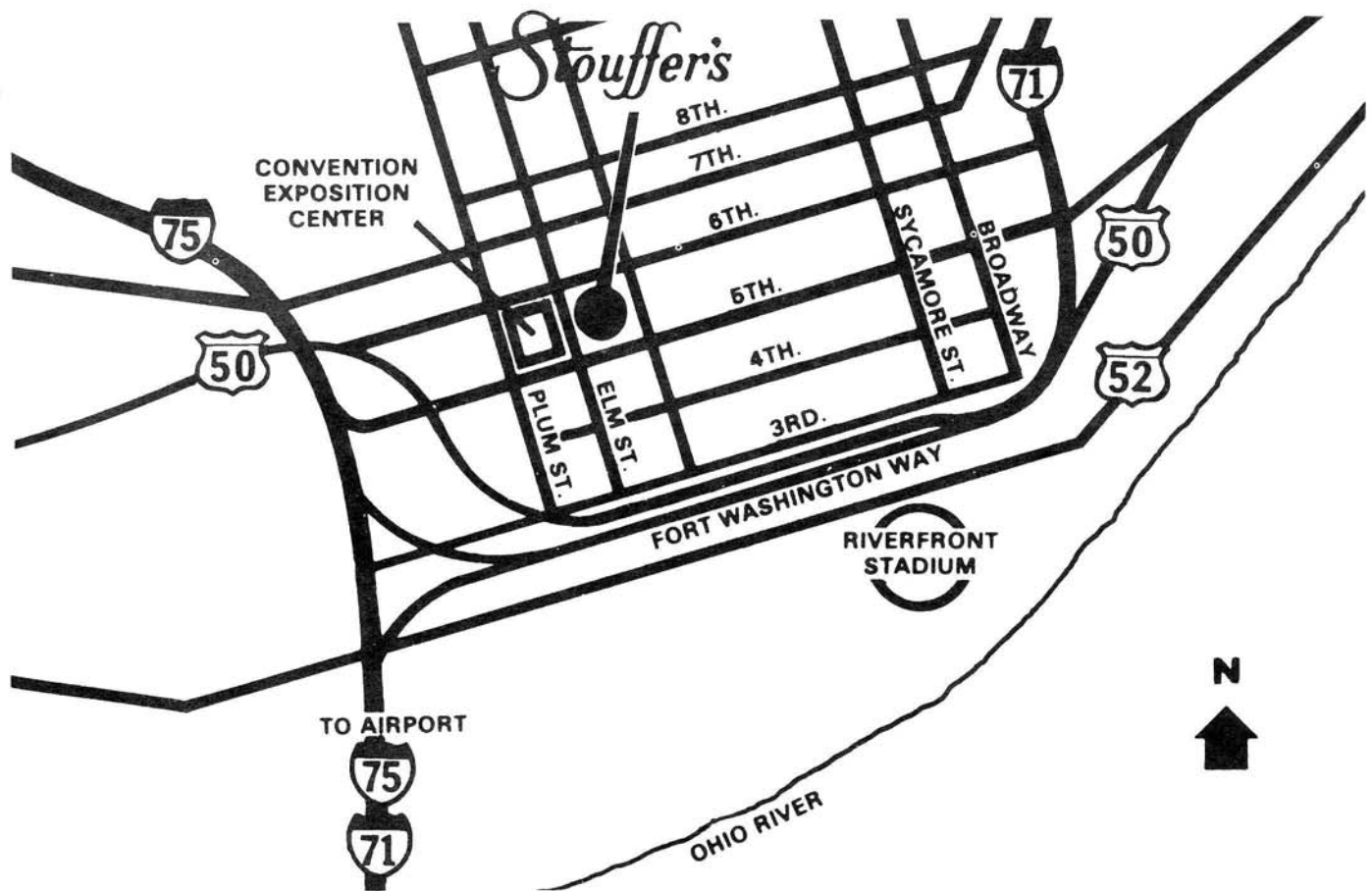

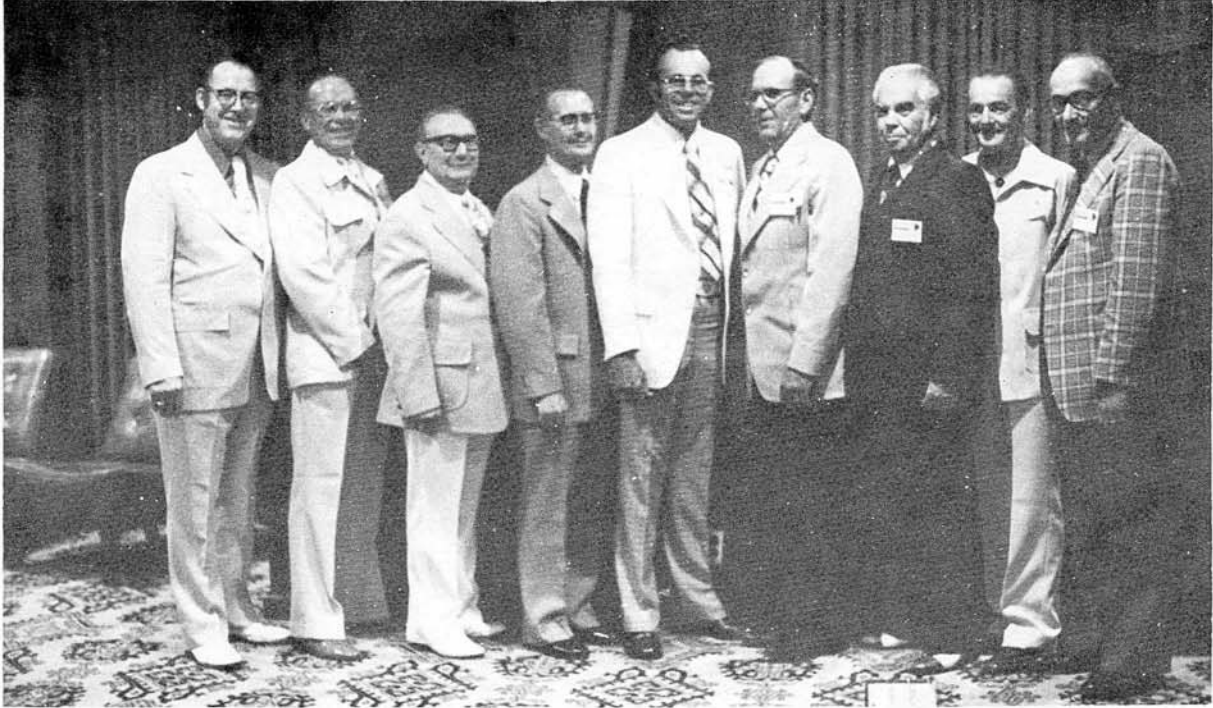
